This last half term is rushing past and life is getting very hectic for all. We wanted to share a last update for the year.

Staffing Updates for 2022-2023

As +mentioned in previous communications, Katt Allen and Hannah Knapp are moving to pastures new and we thank them both for their support, friendship and commitment to the school and our children over many years. They are both moving on to new and exciting challenges.

Emma Coulson has returned to school for the last two weeks of term following her initial surgery. Whilst the surgery went well and the prognosis remains very good, Emma has got to have a follow up surgery. She is waiting for a date and will be at school until this next surgery. It is envisaged that she is likely to need a further short recuperation of 3-4 weeks following her surgery and we will keep you informed as soon as we know dates.

From September, Kate Gemmell will be taking on the temporary role of Executive Headteacher – providing overall leadership to both Grindleford Primary School (whilst they recruit their next Headteacher) and Bamford Primary School.

In order to pro-actively manage these temporary changes, the Governing Board has reviewed our financial position and have taken the decision to 'Back-fill' some of the Headteacher responsibilities and take on additional teacher hours so that we may:

- Minimise disruptions to Class Oak by having internal supply rather than external supply to cover Emma Coulson's next absence
- Provide additional teacher support to the EYFS/Y1/Y2 class to support the teaching of English and Maths for the year
- Provide stability in all the classrooms

We have recently advertised for a full time teacher (one-year contract initially) and are delighted to announce that Miss Rebecca Flanagan will be joining us in September and will be the class teacher for Class Ash. She will be supported and mentored by Jen Chapman who will now take on the temporary promotion to 'Acting Assistant Headteacher'.

Jen Chapman has recently completed her National Professional Qualification for Senior Leadership and this opportunity will enable her to continue to develop her career. She is also a fully qualified SENCO and soon to be fully qualified Designated Safeguarding lead so will also provide support to me for these roles in school.

Jen Chapman will provide the cover for Class Oak when Emma is away from school, supported by Anne Gartside and the other TAs in school.

When not providing cover for Emma, Jen will be supporting the delivery of key subjects for some of the morning timetable and will provide interventions and input across school for any remaining time.

Jen will also provide cover for Miss Flanagan who will need time to complete her ongoing training, so Jen will lead one afternoon per week in Class Ash.

Mr Friend and Mrs Coulson will continue to lead their own areas of responsibility and maintain their classes for the year, ably supported by Anne Gartside, Sue Somerset and Sarah Knapp.

Miss Flanagan is very excited about working with her new class and joining us and she will be in school to complete additional transition with the children who are due in Ash Class (Current Y2 and Y3) on Monday and Tuesday. The Year 3 and 4 children have already met her as she taught them as part of the interview process this week. We were very fortunate as we received over 30 applications for the role and Emma Coulson, Jen Chapman and I (the interview panel) were united in its choice of new teacher for Class Ash. I'm sure that you will make Miss Flanagan feel very welcome.

Finally, we would like to say huge thanks to Kirsten Lewis who has successfully completed her teacher training and has provided support and stability to Class Oak during Mrs Coulson's recent leave. She has been a brilliant Student Teacher and we wish her every good luck in her new, permanent teaching role in Sheffield.
